

Pre-Surgery Instructions

You may drop off your pet between 7:30 am and 8:30 am on the day of your appointment. Our address is 115B Commons Way in Central. We are just off Hwy 93, next to the Central Library.

Please do not feed your pet anything after midnight the day of surgery.

- If you are bringing in a **feral** cat, it must be in a humane trap. Traps are available to rent (refundable deposit) at the Pickens County Animal Shelter (864-898-5936). Check their website for hours.
- If you are bringing in a **domesticated cat**, it must be in a carrier. Please put your last name and the animal's name on the carrier. **A cat brought in a regular cat carrier is considered a domesticated pet and you will be responsible for its surgery expenses.**
- If you are bringing in a **dog**, it must be on a leash.
- We will need proof of rabies vaccination (cats and dogs). If you do not have this, we will administer the vaccination for an \$10 fee. This is required by law.
- When you check in, we will go over other services you might be interested in for your pet. Our services and prices are available on our website at clemsonpawpartners.org.
- We will call you when your pet is ready to go home. We close at 4:00 pm. You will be sent home with post-surgery instructions.

We ask that you please have the courtesy to let us know if you will not be able to make your appointment.
